2023 Workshop Locations, Travel Times and Parking

Below are estimated drive times from Celebration Hall at St. Anastasia (Festival Headquarters), 5202 A1A S. to the following locations:

- Frank Butler Park East, 5860 A1A S. 3 minutes
- St. Johns County Ocean Pier Park, 350 A1A Beach Blvd. 9 minutes
- St. Augustine Alligator Farm, 999 Anastasia Blvd. 10 minutes
- St. Augustine Lighthouse 100 Red Cox Dr. 10 minutes
- Matanzas Inlet, 8805 A1A S. (end of the boardwalk on the East Parking lot (beach side) 10 minutes
- Marineland Rock Beach, 9700 Oceanshore Blvd. 13 minutes
- Washington Oaks Gardens State Park, 6400 Oceanshore Blvd. 17 minutes
- Downtown Plaza (Gazebo), 170 St. George St. 20 minutes (see parking info below)
- Flagler College, 74 King St., Henry Flagler statue 20 minutes (see parking info below)
- Castillo de San Marcos, 1 S Castillo Dr. 20 minutes (see parking info below)
- St. Augustine Municipal Marina, 111 Avenida Menendez 20 minutes (see parking info below)
- Vilano Beach Pier, 260 Vilano Rd. 30 minutes

NOTE - The Bridge of Lions goes up on the hour and ½ past (every 30 minutes). Traffic is heavier during peak hours (7-9 AM and 4-6 PM) Please plan accordingly so you are not late for your event.

Where is the best/easiest place to find parking in downtown St. Augustine? Parking can be a challenge in the downtown St. Augustine area. Here is some helpful information.

Parking for the Municipal Marina Boat Trips: All boat trips leaving from the Municipal Marina at 111 Avenida Menendez must find offsite parking. The Municipal Marina does <u>not</u> have a parking lot. There is metered street parking and paid lots within walking distance. Please allow at least 20 minutes to park and walk to the Marina for boat trips. Please note that metered parking is FREE after 5PM and on Sundays.

Parking for Sigma's Historic St. Augustine Architecture Photo Walk with Brett Wells Field Workshop: This field workshop will meet at Flagler College, 74 King St., at the Henry Flagler statue and begin promptly at 8 AM. Please allow 20 minutes to park and walk. There is a metered parking lot around the Plaza and along the street for you to utilize. You must pay for parking from 8 AM to 5 PM. Please note that metered parking is FREE after 5 PM and on Sundays. If you cannot find parking around the Plaza, there is a parking garage behind the Visitors Information Center, located at 10 W. Castillo Dr. for \$15 or side street parking.

Parking for the Castillo de San Marcos and the Old City Gate: can be found in the Castillo lot, on a side street or at the Historic Downtown Parking Garage.
